Description:

Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) affects many people and increasingly has been an area of attention. PTSD is, in the clinician's view, not pathology but a learned response to surviving horrific circumstances. Specialized treatment is essential for this population, in addition to training for those clinicians who work with them. This workshop will address types of traumatic events, signs and symptoms, co-occurring disorders and considerations essential in working with this population. An Integrated Model of Trauma Treatment developed by the presenter will be presented and discussed in detail.

Robert Bleiwas, LCSW, MA, CASAC is a therapist in private practice in Pomona, New York. He has both Masters degrees in Social Work and Psychology, state and international certifications in addiction and certification in hypnosis and hypnotherapy. He has worked with hundreds of traumatized children, adolescents and adults with PTSD and has developed an integrative model of treatment. He is member of the American Academy of Experts in Traumatic Stress, the National Center for Crisis Management, the American Psychotherapy and Medical Hypnosis Association and other clinical associations.
