Nonverbal and Verbal Nuances in Therapeutic Interventions

This discussion will explore nonverbal and verbal nuances of every therapeutic interchange. The nonverbal components of nonverbal cue delivery, nonverbal cue receipt, posture, action and presence in communication dyads will be explored. We will also look at nuances in verbal components of dialogue including pace, prosody and tone as building blocks of verbal interchange.

Nuances will be highlighted as we engage in practice dialogues in dyads, incorporating the nonverbal and verbal features that have been identified. This integrative work draws on the psychoanalytic research of Dr. Judith Kestenberg who pioneered incorporating Laban/Bartenieff movement research profiles with psychoanalytic principles, as well as the contemporary approach of mindfulness.

This workshop appeals to anyone who yearns to increase their effectiveness in the integration of verbal and nonverbal interchange. It appeals to the beginner as well as the advanced professional as it is directed toward awareness of nuance, which is an ongoing professional challenge.

Dr. Margaret L. Herzog, PhD has been a clinical psychologist for over 30 years. She has presented on nuances of communication to lawyers, financial specialists, mental health specialists, mediators, and collaborative specialists at NYACP, IACP, and the NY Woman's Bar Association. She has presented internationally in the UK to antenatal counselors. Dr. Herzog has a private practice in Larchmont, NY.
