In these difficult financial times, there is increasing pressure to cultivate and maintain referral sources. This presentation will elucidate how what transpires during the referral process can affect the patient, the therapist and the ongoing therapy. Each of these individuals brings their current issues and histories into the mix creating a unique, complex interplay of forces which dynamically affect one another. Due to a convergence of financial, professional and personal anxieties in a particular referral situation, therapists may become distracted from their usual mode of listening to and working with a patient. It is more likely in these situations for there to be a diffusion of boundaries amongst all the participants and a greater tendency for difficulties to arise. Dr. Muller will make recommendations about how best to handle the variety of issues that arise when working with new referrals.
