## Dear Governor Cuomo:

As a Licensed Clinical Social Worker providing vital mental health services at (name of your practice/agency and location), I am writing to respectfully urge you sign SB 5960/AB8140 into law.

This bill would allow Licensed Clinical Social Workers (LCSWs) to directly bill Medicaid for their services. LCSWs represent the largest group of mental health practitioners in the nation. They are often the first to diagnose and treat people with mental disorders and various emotional and behavioral disturbances. LCSWs are essential to a variety of client-centered settings, including community mental health centers, hospitals, substance use treatment and recovery programs, schools, primary health care centers, child welfare agencies, aging services, employee assistance programs, and private practice settings.

Clinical Social Work focuses on the emotional, and mental health of individuals, couples, families, and groups. The profession includes the scope of practice of the LMSW, allows the diagnosis of mental, emotional, behavioral, addictive and developmental disorders and disabilities, the development and implementation of appropriate assessment-based treatment plans; and the provision of crisis oriented psychotherapy, including brief, short-term and long-term psychotherapy and psychotherapeutic treatment. In addition, LCSWs are the only licensed mental health professionals that assess the person-in-environment. This is the essential practice-guiding principle that highlights the importance of understanding an individual in light of the environmental contexts in which that person lives and acts (family finances, connections, living situation, religion, employment, etc...).

Further, Article 163 of the Education Law authorizes a qualified LCSW to practice mental health counseling, marriage and family therapy, creative arts therapy and psychoanalysis. Given the breadth of such a scope, LCSWs are a vital component of the community mental health system and as such, should be utilized to broaden access to crucial mental health services.
